InterArt Greifswald 2010

Dear Sirs,

We are pleased to invite you to the international exhibition "InterArt", which takes place annually in Greifswald. The vernissage of "InterArt2010" will begin on Mai 5, 07,00 p.m. Our gallery "Pommernhus" is as well the exhibition site as the place of the above mentioned institutions. The official operator and responsible authority is the Helmut-Maletzke-Foundation as incorporated foundation under civil law.

During the art exhibitions nearly 20 artists from 20 countries around the world introduce their creations. According to the well-established tradition all artists, if requested, together with partners, are invited to stay 4 days at least in Greifswald. In this time a lot of talks, convivial get-together, and excursions around the Baltic Sea will be arranged. We will visit local artists, museums, concerts.

In connection with earlier exhibitions in Los Angeles, Paris, and Berlin, the main tenor of "InterArt" is to provide a general idea of the global artistic activities and to encourage the artists to go in personal contact with each other for exchanging experiences. This will be more and more attended at home and abroad.

Please note the following details: Parts of the exhibition are only paintings and small sculptures ore potteries. Up to 5 pictures should not exceed the high of 2,50m and breadth of 3,00m. Subject and topic are optional. We have no jury; but in subject to the local conditions the organizer is entitled to make modifications in exceptional cases. Each artist has to organise the outgoing and return transport of the exhibits, provided with the required equipment like hooks, picture frames etc., on **their own responsibility and costs**. Deadline is Mai 5, 2010, at 10:00 a.m. We need also a list with the following details: name, address, titles of exhibits, technical picture data, dimension, production year, and prices. A printable photo of the paintings together with a short biography (preferably in English) together with a personal photo of the participant will be also necessary. The photo of a representative painting for the catalogue should have 3 MB, at least 1.5 MB. Please send the information as soon as possible to the "Pommernhus". If requested, we would like to assist in organising accommodation. Travel and accommodation expenses have to be covered by the artists.

Because of "Pommernhus" does not provide any insurance cover, we would like to ask each artist to close any insurance and to send us a copy of the contract conclusion with a supplying company (UPS, DHL, etc.) as well as the dates and details of the outgoing and return transport.
